Additional Record of *Glipa iriei* (Coleoptera, Mordellidae) from Northern Vietnam

Glipa iriei is a little-known mordellid and has been known from Japan (the Ryukyu Islands), Taiwan, Hainan Island and Vietnam. However, its record from Vietnam (XIANG & YANG, 1993) has no further data than "1 $\stackrel{\circ}{\circ}$, 1 $\stackrel{\circ}{\circ}$, Yuenan (越南)". I am going to record this species with detailed collecting data.
