

New Records of Staphylinid Beetles (Coleoptera) from the Island of Goshoura-jima of the Amakusa Islands in Kumamoto Prefecture, Western Japan

So far as it is known to the author, no staphylinid beetle has hitherto been recorded from the island of Goshoura-jima of the Amakusa Islands in Kumamoto Prefecture, western Japan. Through the courtesy of Mr. S. ONODA, I had an opportunity to examine a short series of staphylinid beetles obtained by himself from this island on August 3rd, 1994. They are classified into four species, all of which are new to the fauna of the island. They are recorded below.

1. *Anotylus japonicus* (CAMERON) 1 ♂.
2. *Anotylus marginatus* (WEISE) 1 ♀.
3. *Algon grandicollis* SHARP 1 ♂.
4. *Zyras (Zyras) pictus* (SHARP) 1 ♀.
