New Record of *Trichocanteres fasciculifer* (Coleoptera, Trogossitidae) from Thailand




Fig. 1. Habitus of *Trichocateres fasciculifer* (left) and its distribution map (right). Scale = 1.0 mm.

The genus *Trichocateres* Kolibáč, 2010 belongs to the tribe Lophocaterini, subfamily Lophocaterinae (Kolibáč, 2013). *Trichocateres fasciculifer* Kolibáč, 2010 (Fig. 1 left) is monotypic species of the genus, and is very unique species in having remarkable dorsal habitus. This species was described on the basis of three specimens collected from Assan (India) and North Laos (Fig. 1 right), and seems to be relatively rare (Kolibáč, 2010).

Recently, I examined one specimen of this species collected from Thailand, and record it for the first time from Thailand as follows.
