

A New Record of *Bisnius fimetarius* (Coleoptera, Staphylinidae) from Taiwan

Notes. *Bisnius fimetarius* is recorded not only from Taiwan but also from East Asia for the first time, since the species has so far been known from Europe, Russia, Canada, North Africa, Central Asia and India.

Distribution. Europe; Russia; Canada; North Africa; Central Asia; India and Taiwan (new record).
