

A New Record of *Caenolanguria azurea* (Coleoptera, Erotylidae, Languriinae) in the Malay Peninsula

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Caenolanguria azurea VILLIERS, 1945 was described from southern Sumatra (VILLIERS, 1945) and has not yet been recorded from anywhere since then. Here, we report the additional record of this species, which is the first record from the Malay Peninsula.

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Caenolanguria azurea VILLIERS, 1945

Specimen examined. 1 ex. (in 99.5% ethanol), Batu 19 (19 mile), Perak, Malay Peninsula, Malaysia, 4°21' N, 101°19' E, 650–700 m alt., 2.III.2012, R. NITTA leg.

Distribution. Malay Peninsula (Perak) (new record) and Sumatra (Palembang).

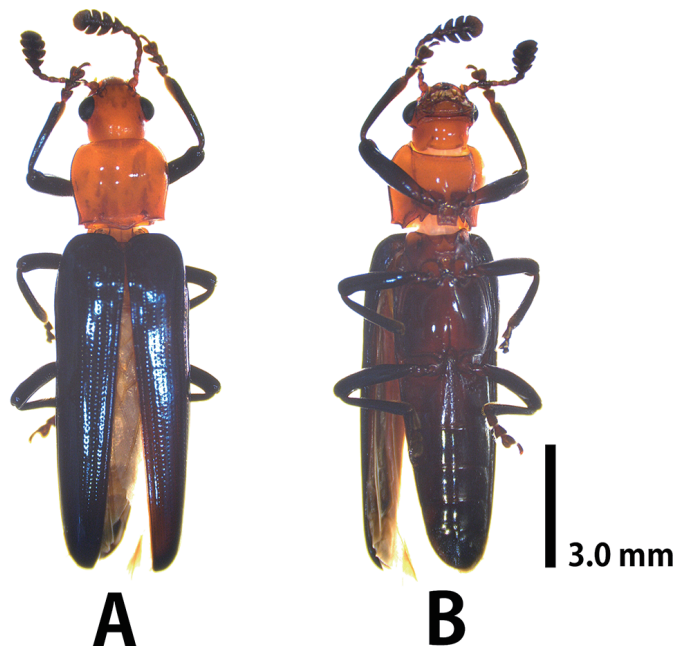


Fig. 1. *Caenolanguria azurea* VILLIERS. ——— A, Dorsal view; B, ventral view.
