New Localities of *Obrium elongatum* and *O. huae* (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae)

Obrium elongatum and O. huae were described based on the single male specimen from northern Vietnam each (NIISATO, 1998), and no additional record of both species have been known so far. As a result of the field surveys in Laos, I could examine a number of specimens of both species as listed below. This short report is not only the second records for the species after the original description but also the first records from Laos.
