

## Additional Records of *Merionoeda fusca* GERESSITT et RONDON (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae)

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*Merionoeda fusca* is a characteristic species in having the short elytra with black external margins and largely black hind femur beyond the club part (GERESSITT & RONDON, 1970), and has so far been known from Laos and Yunnan (LÖBL & SMETANA, 2010; NIISATO & LIN, 2013). We examined the additional specimens of this species including the new record from Thailand as listed below.

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### *Merionoeda fusca* GERESSITT et RONDON, 1970

*Distribution.* Laos, Thailand (new record) and China: Yunnan.

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
