
## Occurrence of *Agrilus shibatai* Y. Kurosawa (Coleoptera, Buprestidae) in Taiwan

Agrilus shibatai Y. Kurosawa, 1964 belonging to the tribe Agrilini, subfamily Agrilinae (Coleoptera, Buprestidae) has hitherto been recorded from Japan (the Ryukyus: Amami-Ôshima, Okinawajima, Ishigakijima, Iriomotejima and Yonagunijima Isls.) (Онмомо & Fukutomi, 2013). In October 2015, the second and third authors collected this species for the first time from Taiwan, as recorded below.

## Agrilus shibatai Y. Kurosawa, 1964

[Japanese name: Shibata-naga-tamamushi]

Specimens examined. 1 ♂, 1 ♀, Taiwan, Pingtung County, Hengshun Township, Kenting National Forest Recreation Area, Visiting Area I (Dormitory to Viewing Tower), 13.X.2015, H. YOSHITAKE leg.

*Distribution*. Japan (the Ryukyus: Amami-Ôshima, Okinawajima, Ishigakijima, Iriomotejima and Yonagunijima Isls.); Taiwan — new record.

Notes. At first, we suspected that the two specimens from Taiwan belonged to Agrilus hornianus KERREMANS, 1912, with which A. shibatai was considered to be conspecific in the original description (Y. KUROSAWA, 1964). However, we identified these specimens as A. shibatai, based on comparison with the images of a syntype of A. hornianus (National Museum of Natural Science, Taichung, 2017). The syntype of A. hornianus bears a conspicuous median projection at the apex of pygidium, whereas each of the specimen examined lacks a projection on the pygidium. In Japan, A. shibatai were captured from April to July on Castanopsis sieboldii lutchuensis (Okinawajii, in Japanese), the host plant of this species (JENDEK & GREBENNIKOV, 2011; OHMOMO & FUKUTOMI, 2013).

JENDEK (2003) treated *A. hokkaidoensis* TÔYAMA, 1985 as a junior synonym of *A. shibatai*. However, OHMO-MO & FUKUTOMI (2013) revised the taxonomic identity of *A. hokkaidoensis* and treated it as a good species differing from *A. shibatai*, based on differences between the two in distribution range, which is limited in Hokkaido (*A. hokkaidoensis*) or in the Ryukyus (*A. shibatai*), and structures of the prosternal process, which is lingulate (*A. hokkaidoensis*) or rectangular (*A. shibatai*).
