

A Record of *Merionoeda fusca* GRESSITT et RONDON (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae) from Northern Vietnam

After our recent report on the distribution of *Merionoeda fusca* GRESSITT et RONDON, 1970 (NIISATO & YOKOI, 2015), we found the same species from northern Vietnam in the cabinet of the first author. It is the first record of this species from Vietnam. The collecting data is as follows: 1 ♀, Deo Pha Din, Son La Province, Vietnam, 5.V.1995, M. OWADA leg. (Fig. 1). Including this record, *M. fusca* is now widely known from northern Indochina belonging to four countries: China (Yunnan), Vietnam, Laos, and Thailand. (GRESSITT & RONDON, 1970; HUBWEBER *et al.*, 2010; NIISATO & LIN, 2013; NIISATO & YOKOI, *op. cit.*).
