

A First Record of *Spilopopillia sexguttata* (FAIRMAIRE) (Coleoptera, Scarabaeidae, Rutelinae) from Laos and Vietnam

In the genus *Spilopopillia* (KRAATZ, 1892) (Rutelinae, Anomalini, Popilliina), four species have been known from the Oriental Region (FAIRMAIRE, 1887; KRAATZ, 1892 b; LIN, 1988; MIYAKE, 1989 a). Recently I had an opportunity to conduct a field survey in Laos, and examined specimens of the genus housed in Tokyo University of Agriculture, Atsugi, Kanagawa, Japan (TUA). As a result, I found one unrecorded species in Laos and Vietnam. Herein I report *S. sexguttata* (FAIRMAIRE, 1887) from the countries for the first time.

The examined specimens are preserved in the Laboratory of Entomology, TUA and the National Museum of Nature and Science, Tokyo. Spilopopillia sexguttata (FAIRMAIRE, 1887)

Popillia sexguttata FAIRMAIRE, 1887: 115 (type locality: Yunnan).*Spilopopillia sexguttata*: KRAATZ, 1892 a: 180.

Distribution. China (Sichuan and Yunnan) (FAIRMAIRE, 1887; LIN, 1992), India (Assam, Sikkim, and West Bengal) (OHAUS, 1908; ARROW, 1917) and Thailand (MIYAKE, 1989 b); Laos and Vietnam — new records.

Notes. The distributional record of *Spilopopillia sexguttata* from Thailand was reported by MIYAKE (1989 b), but in the course of this study I found that MIYAKE (1989 a) had made a misidentification for a species of this genus, confusing one known species with the other unknown species. In order to check the accuracy of the species identification by MIYAKE (1989 b), therefore, I examined the taxonomic voucher of MIYAKE (1989 b), together with other specimens from Thailand and China (Yunnan). With the result that the specimen he reported from Thailand undoubtedly belonged to the species *Spilopopillia sexguttata*.
