

New Distributional Records of *Paracymus atomus* d'ORCHYMONT, 1925 (Coleoptera, Hydrophilidae) from Yonaguni-jima Island, the Ryukyus, Japan

Paracymus atomus d'ORCHYMONT, 1925 (Coleoptera, Hydrophilidae) is distributed in the Oriental Region, including China and Japan (FIKÁČEK *et al.*, 2015; MINOSHIMA & INAHATA, 2019). This species, which was recently discovered from Japan, is known from the islands of Amami-Ōshima, Iriomote-jima, and Ishigaki-jima (MINOSHIMA & INAHATA, 2019).

In this short paper, I record *P. atomus* for the first time from Yonaguni-jima Island in the Ryukyus.
