## A New Record of *Copris arimotoi* (Coleoptera, Scarabaeidae) from Peninsular Malaysia

*Copris arimotoi* was originally described from Sumatera Barat Province, Sumatra, Indonesia (OCHI & ARAYA, 1992) and has been known from only there. In 2013, I collected a male specimen of *Copris arimotoi* in Perak State, Malaysia. This is the first record of this species from Peninsular Malaysia. Its collecting data is: 1  $\sigma^2$ , Gerik, 1,100 m alt., Perak State, Malaysia, 8–III–2013, S. KAKIZOE leg.

Distribution. Sumatra, Peninsular Malaysia (new record).
