

New record of *Sinonychus satoi* (Coleoptera, Elmidae) from Amami-Ôshima, Japan

Until now, *Sinonychus satoi* YOSHITOMI et NAKAJIMA has been known from Tokashiki-jima and Zamami-jima (YOSHITOMI & NAKAJIMA, 2007). We collected this species from small streams at the southern part of Amami-Ôshima. In this brief report, we will record it for the first time from Amami-Ôshima.
