Staphylinid Beetles (Coleoptera) Newly Recorded from Miyake-jima Island of the Izu Islands, Japan

Fifty-seven species of the family Staphylinidae, except for pselaphine and scaphidiine beetles, have hitherto been reported by Watanabe and Sohma (1972) from Miyake-jima Island of the Izu Islands, Japan. At the opportunity of investigating the insect fauna of the island, six unrecorded staphylinid species were obtained by myself at Tsubota on November 22, 1971. They are recorded below.
